You need ✓ 2 paper clips
 ✓ a classmate

✓ 10 counters of one colour
 ✓ 10 counters of another colour

$$2 + 3 = 5$$

Game

- Four in a Row is a game to help you practise your addition facts. The first player puts the two paper clips under two of the numbers in the list of addends below the board.
- The player then adds the numbers and covers up the answer on the board with a counter.
- The next player moves one of the paper clips to make a new addition fact. This player then covers the answer to the new fact on the board.
- Continue taking turns, moving only one paper clip each time, until one player has four counters next to each other in a vertical, horizontal, or diagonal line. If neither player ends up with four counters next to each other, the game is a draw.

Note: Both paper clips can be under the same addend.
