

# Fraction Distraction

**You need** ✓ a photocopy of the Fraction Domino cards copymaster  
✓ 2 classmates ✓ a calculator (optional)

## Game

Play this game with 2 classmates.

- One player lays the Fraction Domino cards face down and mixes them up.
- Each player chooses 7 cards. The rest are put in a pile face down.
- The players hold their cards so that the other players can't see them.
- There are 8 cards in the game that show 2 equivalent numbers, for example,
- Each player shows the card in their hand that has the largest equivalent numbers on it.
- The player with the largest equivalent numbers starts the game. They choose one of their domino cards and put it face up in the centre.
- The next player joins one of their dominoes to the domino on the table so that 2 equivalent numbers are next to each other.
- If a player doesn't have any dominoes that link to one of the tabled dominoes, that player picks up a domino card from the pile, and it is the next person's turn. If there are no cards left to pick up, the player misses their next turn.
- The players take turns to keep joining new dominoes to the domino chain.
- During the game, if a player puts down a card with 2 equivalent numbers on it, that player has another turn.
- The first person to have no cards left in their hand is the winner.
