You need: square dot paper, card, scissors, felt-tip pens or coloured pencils

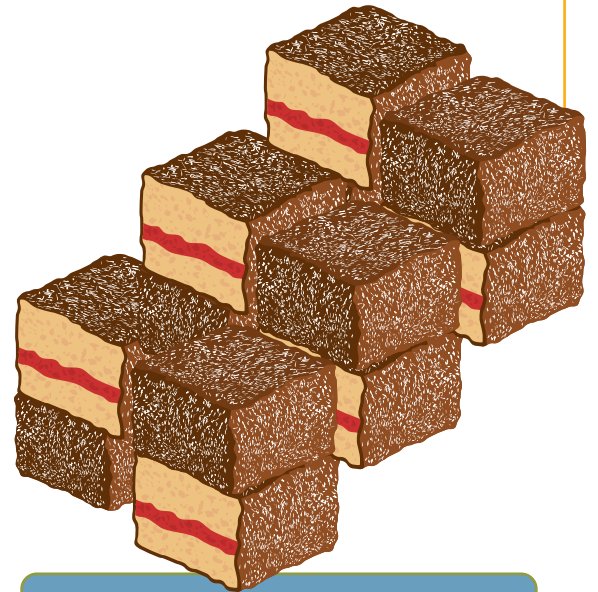
ACTIVITY

Your mum is on the local kindergarten committee. Its members are getting ready for their annual fundraising event, a lamington drive.

The lamingtons are to be packed in presentation boxes, each holding 12. Each lamington measures 8 centimetres by 4 centimetres and is 5 centimetres high.

Your mum has agreed to design the boxes, but she is very busy, so she asks you to do this for her. Design at least 3 boxes so that she will have a choice.

1. Draw the nets for your containers, showing the necessary measurements.
2. Which container do you think is most suitable? Give reasons for your decision.
3. Make the container.



A net is a 2-D pattern for making a 3-D object out of card or other thin material.
