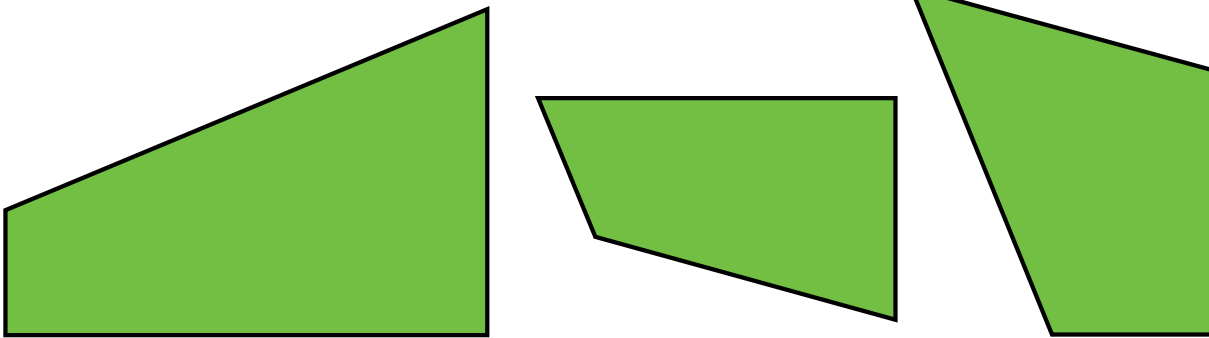


# Shaping Up

## Activity Two

<p>1. Cut a geometric shape out of cardboard.</p>	<p>2. Draw three lines across the shape.</p>	<p>3. Copy the shape and its lines into your book.</p>	<p>4. Cut up your cardboard shape along the lines that you have drawn.</p>
<p>5. Put your initials on the back of each piece and put all the pieces in an envelope.</p>	<p>6. On the outside of the envelope, write your name and draw the outline of the geometric shape.</p>		<p>7. Give your puzzle to a classmate to solve. Check their answer.</p>
