A game for 2 or more players

Equipment

- Set of cards
- Collection of red and black counters (red represent -1, black +1)
- Paper to record transactions

How to play

- 1. Shuffle the cards
- 2. Give each player 5 black and 5 red counters to start with
- 3. First player selects a card and follows the card instructions, adjusting counters accordingly i.e. "you vacuumed the house 2 bonuses" player takes 2 black counters from the bank or removes 2 red counters from their pile.
- 4. Cards are shuffled and placed face down again after each players turn.
- 5. At the end of the game each player receives \$1 for each black counter and loses \$1 for each red counter they have, the player with the most money wins.
