

Addition facts to 20

Purpose:

To help your child to recall their addition facts to 20

What you need:

- Number cards 0 – 10
- You can print these on to card or you can use playing cards (Jack = 0)
- Paper and pencil to keep score

What to do:

Make a set of number cards for each player

Each player holds all their cards in a pile in one hand.

The players sit opposite each other.

Each person turns over a card and places it on the table.

The first person to correctly add the two numbers together wins a point.

$$4 + 5 = 9$$

The cards then go back at the bottom of the player's pile.

Players shuffle their pack throughout the game.

What to expect your child to do:

To instantly recall the addition facts up to 20.

Variations:

The cards can be used for multiplying.

He Kupu Māori:

cards	kāri
total	tapeke
add	tāpiri

He Whakawhitinga Kōrero:

- Anei ō kāri. (*Here are your cards.*)
- He aha te tapeke? (*Whats the total?*)
- Ko te tekau mā toru te tapeke. (*13 is the total*)
- Tāpirihia ngā tau. (*Add the numbers.*)
- Ehara tēnā i te tapeke, ko te tekau mā rima kē! (*Thats not the total, its 15!*)
