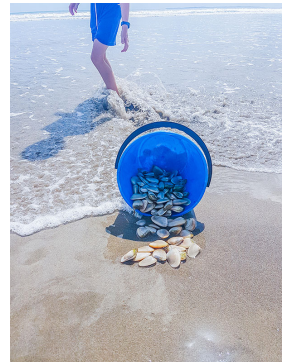


1. It is the opening of the new marae. 48 buses arrive.

How many trays should there be?



5. Aotearoa has a starfish called patakaroa that has 11 arms.  
If 78 patakaroa lined up on the beach, how many arms would that be?



6. Nana cuts each pumpkin into eight pieces for the hāngi.  
She cuts 704 pieces.  
How many pumpkins does she use?



7. Each waka has a crew of seventeen kaimahi.  
There are 153 kaimahi altogether.  
How many waka will they fill?



8. How many legs are on 421 octapuses (wheke)?
