

Quick Thinking

You need photocopies of the game sheet copymaster (1 for each player)
 a dice 3 or more classmates

Game

Each person needs a game sheet. The sheet has 10 number statements on it. The idea is to make as many true statements as possible, using the numbers thrown.

How to play:

- One person rolls the dice and calls out the number.
- The other players enter that number in one of the 20 number boxes on their game sheet. (The person throwing the dice should allow only about 15 seconds for this.)
- If you can't find a place to use the number thrown, you must enter an **X** in one of the empty boxes.
- Once you have written a number or an **X** in a box, it must stay there.
- After 20 rolls of the dice, the game finishes. Players check their game sheet and score a point (✓) for each true statement they have made.
- The player with the most points wins the game.
