

Sketching the Etching

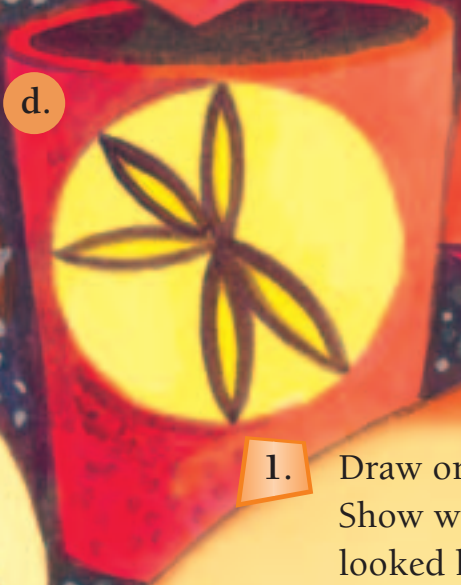
- You need** mirrors tracing paper

Activity
