

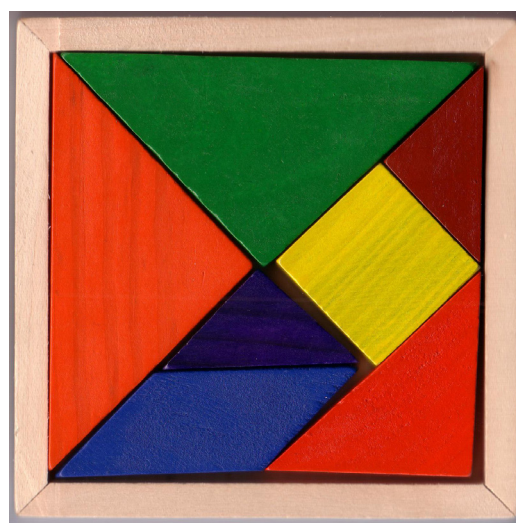
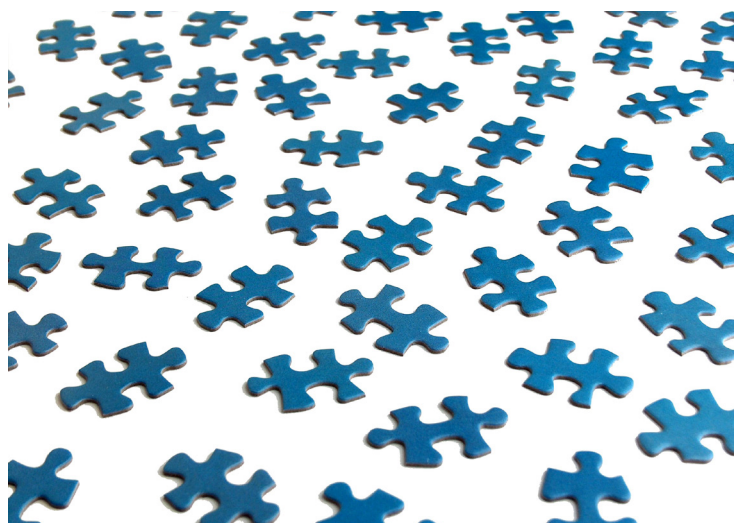


# He Momo Panga

E whai ake nei ētahi taurira pātai me ētahi taurira tohutohu e hāngai ana ki te pāngarau me ētahi momo kēmu. Koirā pea hei tīmatatanga whakawhiti kōrero mā kōrua ko tō tamaiti.

Here are some possible pāngarau questions or instructions about different sorts of games that might start conversations between you and your child.

Pangahono: Mō te Tae	Jigsaw Puzzles: About Colour
He aha te tae o te wehenga e rapu nā koe?	What colour is the piece you are looking for?
He aha te tae o te wehenga ka piri atu ki konā?	What colour is the piece that goes in there?
Kia tea ake te kākārīki mō tēnā wāhi.	It needs to be a lighter green for there.
Kia uriuri ake te kahurangi o te moana.	The blue for the ocean is darker.
Kimihia ngā wehenga mō tēnei wāhi, he kōpurepure ngā tae.	Look for the pieces for this area, the colours are spotty/blotchy.
He aha ngā tae o ōna kākahu hei kimi māu.	What are the colours of his/her clothes that you could look for?
Hurihia tēnā wehenga kia tauriterite ai ngā tae.	Turn that piece so that the colours match.



He Kōrero mō te Panga Arorau	Talk About Logic Puzzles
Me pēhea te hurihuri kia rārangi mai ai ngā whero?	How do you turn it so that all the reds are in a line?
He aha pea te mahi tuatahi?	What do you think we should do first?
Wetekina ngā āhua.	Separate the shapes.
Me pēhea te wewete i ngā āhua?	How can the shapes be separated?
Me pēhea te whakanoho i ēnei āhua e rua kia piri tahi ai.	How could these two shapes be put together?
He aha ētahi whakanōhanga rerekē mō ēnei āhua e rua?	What are some different ways of putting these two shapes together.

Pangahono: Mō te Āhua	Jigsaw Puzzles: About Shape
He tapatoru pea te āhua e tika ana mō konā.	Maybe its a triangle shape that will fit in there.
Pēhea nei te āhua o te wehenga ka noho atu ki konā?	What shape is the piece which goes in there?
Kimihia ngā wehenga mō ngā kokonga, ka whakanoho atu ai.	Look for the corner pieces and put them in.
Mahia mai ngā tapa o te pangahono i te tuatahi.	Do the edges of the jigsaw puzzle first.
Whakahuihuia ngā wehenga tapa torotika ki konei, koirā ngā wehenga mō ngā taha.	Collect all the pieces with straight edges here, those are the pieces for the sides.
Kāore e tika ana te puna honohono o tēnā wehenga. Kia nui ake.	The connecting tab for that piece is not quite correct. It needs to be bigger.
He torotika ngā tapa o ēnei wehenga, he kōpikopiko ngā tapa o ēnei.	The edges of these pieces are straight, the edges of these a curved.
Kātahi nā te uaua! He ōrite te āhua o ngā wehenga katoa!	Gez this is difficult! The pieces are all the same shape!
Hurhria tēnā wehenga kia pai ai tana noho ki tēnā wāhi.	Turn that piece so that it sits correctly in that space.
Ko te rangi tētahi wāhanga matua o te o te pikitia. Kimihia ngā wehenga katoa mō te rangi.	The sky is one of the main parts of the picture. Look for all the sky pieces.
Whakamātauria tēnei wehenga mō te kahiwi o te rākau.	Try this piece for the trunk of the tree.
Me āta pēpēhi ngā wehenga o te pangahono. Ki te kore e uru pai noa iho, e hē ana tava wāhi.	Gently push the pieces of the puzzle. If they don't join easily then its the wrong place.
